The service is one of the first of its kind in the UK and has been recognised locally and nationally as a model of best practice.

Robert is a podiatrist who has been working as a specialist in biomechanics and in podopaediatrics for 15 years, both within the NHS and in private practice.

He has been an invited speaker at conferences both in the UK and overseas, including the SCP and IOCP, CESPU in Portugal and the Langer Biomechanics Summer School. These are unique training opportunities for podiatrists, enabling us to assess and treat proposed fascial contributors to pain or reduced movement. The training covers from the pelvis to the toes.
