SPEAKERS BIOGRAPHIES

Dr Ruth Ashbee

Ruth Ashbee is Chief Clinical Scientist and Honorary Lecturer, Mycology Reference Centre, Department of Microbiology at the University of Leeds .

Andy Horwood

Andy Horwood is a musculoskeletal podiatrist with an interest in biomechanics and evolutionary biology. Andy has worked in the independent sector for the last 18 years as well as writing a module for Staffordshire Universities MSc in Clinical Podiatric Biomechanics. Andy continues as a module leader in Origins and Principles of Podiatric Biomechanics on the MSc and is an Honorary Visiting Fellow of Staffordshire University. Andy is also Technical Director at Healthystep (Sensograph) Ltd and a Clinical adviser (musculoskeletal) to Bailey's Instruments. Andy is a member of The Society for the Study of Human Biology.

Mr Jason Hargrave

Mr Hargrave has continued to work in both the NHS and private sector, training in podiatric surgery after passing his primary membership (Podiatry Association) at The University of Manchester in 1993. Award of Fellowship was gained in 1995, after surgical training at Lewisham University Hospital (Fellowship of The College of Podiatrists (surgery) - FCPoS). After a 3-year period as an Associate Specialist, he secured a Consultant NHS position at Charing Cross Hospital (Hammersmith & Fulham NHS PCT) in 1998 and had also previously set up the Podiatric Surgery services for Lambeth NHS PCT at St Thomas's Hospital in 1996 and later for Sutton & Merton NHS PCT at Sutton Hospital in 2004. After gaining practicing privileges at The Harley Street Clinic in 2002, he has continued to build his private practice with outpatient facilities at 9 Harley Street.

Clifton Bradeley

Clifton Bradeley is a podiatrist of twenty-two years experience in clinical musculoskeletal sports biomechanics, and prior to that he was an elite athlete. Clifton's international running career for England and Great Britain culminated in him setting the British indoor mile record of 3.57.88min/secs against USA in March 1985, whilst taking the place of an injured Sebastian Coe. This was the first time a sub-4 minute mile had been run indoors in the UK. Clifton has carried out approximately 15,000 biomechanical assessments, and has innovated a number of new clinical techniques, culminating in two product innovation awards. He is currently the managing director Sub-4 Ltd, a successful orthotics manufacturing company, whilst part-time he studies for his PhD.
