## Keynote Speakers



#### Martin Fox

Martin works in a community-based NHS lower limb vascular service in the Manchester Local Care Organisation; providing early identification, diagnosis and best clinical

management for people with suspected peripheral arterial disease (PAD). The service in one of the first of its kind in the UK and has been recognised locally and nationally as a model of best practice.



#### Robert Isaacs

Robert is a podiatrist who has been working as a specialist in biomechanics and in podopaediatrics for 15 years, both within the NHS and in private practice.

He has been an invited speaker at conferences both in the UK and overseas, including the SCP and IOCP, CESPU in Portugal and the Langer Biomechanics Summer School. Robert is also a prolific blogger, itinerant speaker and writes for Podiatry Now from time to time. He is the South East hub lead for MSK UK.



#### **Belinda Longhurst**

Qualifying as a Chiropodist from the Sheffield Institute of Chiropodists and Podiatrists in 2003, Belinda then studied for a higher degree and graduated from the University of Southampton

in 2007, where she was awarded a first-class BSc (Hons) degree in Podiatry, with a distinction in clinical practice. Belinda has worked as a private practitioner since 2003 and was also employed as an NHS Podiatrist in Hampshire. She acts as peer reviewer for a variety of professional journals and advisor for BUPA's patient information pages. Her area of special interest is podiatric dermatology and has frequently presented her published work at both national and international conferences.

#### Ian Linane

lan has been in private practice for 25 years working both in his own and multidiscipline clinics. During 10 years of this period he provided Forensic Gait Analysis reports for the courts, in

criminal investigation matters. Additionally he is the founder of Infigo Education, where he writes and presents courses providing COP approved extended scope practice, in the area of Manual Therapy. These courses, now in their 9th year, cover 3 distinct areas: Foot, Ankle and Soft Tissue Mobilisation. They have been taught nationally and internationally. Ian is also qualified in whole body "Fascial Manipulation - Stecco Method" techniques. In January this year he secured COP approval for podiatry specific Stecco Fascial Manipulation courses. These are unique training opportunities for podiatrists, enabling us to assess and treat proposed fascial contributors to pain or reduced movement. The training covers from the pelvis to the toes.

Dave James is a coach, mentor, public speaker and podiatrist. With over 25 years of experience in healthcare, he has worked in the public, voluntary, education and private sectors. Dave is
